

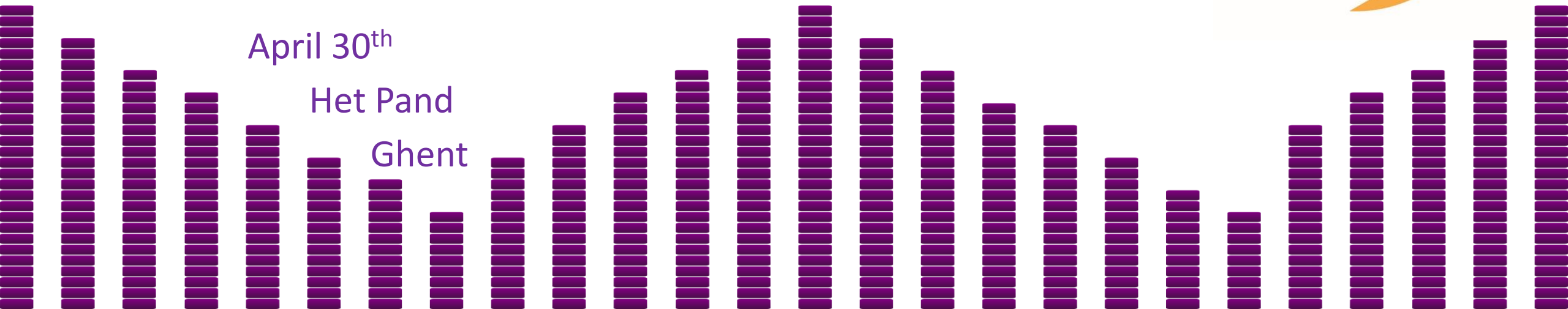

Keynote speaker – prof. dr. Mara Behlau



Prof. dr. Mara Behlau is one of the world's leading voice experts. She is a Brazilian speech-language-pathologist and the director of the "Centro de Estudos da Voz" – CEV. She is also professor at the Graduate Program in Human Communication Disorders at UNIFESP-EPM, São Paulo, Brazil, where she supervises several master and doctorate candidates. She was president of the International Association of Logopedics and Phoniatics (IALP), the Brazilian Society of Laryngology and Voice (SBLV) and the Brazilian Association of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology (SBFa). She has received the ASHA FELLOW title and also the Certificate of Recognition for Outstanding Contributions in International Achievements, both in 2014. She has been involved at The Voice Foundation for more than 30 years. She is the author of more than 100 publications and many textbooks in the area of voice.
